



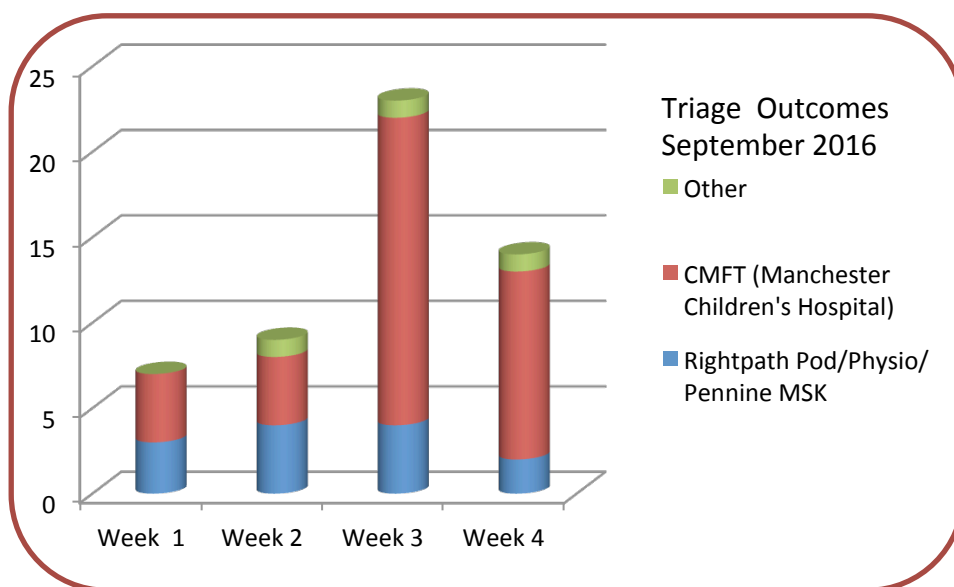
Rightpath newsletter

We have submitted an ethics amendment seeking approval to collect data at 6 months to see whether any children triaged within RightPath have been re-referred to local or regional services within 6 months of the original referral.



This extra step will add to our knowledge of the safety and appropriateness of the triage and provision of care where it occurs at Rightpath sites over time.
